Purpose:

Key Club is designed to serve as a forum for Nürnberg's youth to discuss in English those issues most relevant and current to them, and then to actually have a chance to impact those issues. It encourages their involvement in and support of the community and the DAI through student-led events and fundraising activities.

How Key Club works:

In the few initial meetings of the club, participants will have the opportunity to discuss local, national or international issues of importance to them. Out of these meetings a consensus will be formed and events will be designed and ultimately implemented. Participants benefit greatly in their pursuits from the wide-ranging associates and contact of the DAI. These events are limited only by the imagination of the participants – they can bring awareness to an issue, support the issue through fundraising, or whatever other method the club chooses in order to be involved.
